52. If a damsel that is a virgin be betrothed unto an husband, and a man find her in the city, and lie with her; Then ye shall bring them both out unto the gate of that city, and ye shall stone them with stones that they die; the damsel, because she cried not, being in the city.--22:23-24
53. When two men strive together on with another, and the wife of the one ... putteth forth her hand, and taketh him by the secrets: Then thou shalt cut off her hand, thine eye shall not pity her.--25:11-12
54. The LORD shall make the pestilence cleave unto thee, until he have consumed thee from off the land.--28:21
55. The LORD shall smite thee with a consumption, and with a fever, and with an inflammation, and with an extreme burning, and with the sword, and with blasting, and with mildew; and they shall pursue thee until thou perish.--28:22
56. Thy carcase shall be meat unto all fowls of the air, and unto the

- beasts of the earth, and no man shall fray them away.--28:26

60. The LORD shall smite thee in the knees, and in the legs, with a sore botch that cannot be healed, from the sole of thy foot unto the top of thy head.--28:35

Joshua

75. The LORD God of Israel fought for Israel.-- [10:42](#)

Judges

76. But Adonibezek fled; and they pursued after him, and caught him, and cut off his thumbs and his great toes.-- [1:6](#)
77. Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died.-- [4:21](#)
78. Blessed above women shall Jael the wife of Heber the Kenite be She put her hand to the nail, and her right hand to the workmen's hammer; and with the hammer she smote Sisera, she smote off his head, when she had pierced and stricken through his temples.-- [5:24-26](#)
79. And the Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he ... slew thirty men.-- [14:19](#)
80. And Samson went and caught three hundred foxes, and took firebrands, and turned tail to tail, and put a firebrand in the midst between two tails. And when he had set the brands on fire, he let them go.-- [15:4-5](#)
81. And when he was come into his house, he took a knife, and laid hold on his concubine, and divided her, together with her bones, into twelve pieces, and sent her into all the coasts of Israel.-- [19:29](#)

1 Samuel

82. And he smote the men of Bethshemesh, because they had looked into the ark of the LORD, even he smote of the people fifty thousand and threescore and ten men: and the people lamented, because the LORD had smitten many of the people with a great slaughter.--[6:19](#)

102. They took the king's sons, and slew seventy persons, and put their heads in baskets, and sent him them to Jezreel.--10:7
103. And when he came to Samaria, he slew all that remained unto Ahab in Samaria, till he had destroyed him, according to the saying of the LORD--10:17
104. And the LORD smote the king, so that he was a leper unto the day of his death.--15:5
105. Therefore he smote it; and all the women therein that were with child he ripped up.--15:16
106. The LORD sent lions among them, which slew some of them.--17:25
107. The angel of the LORD went out, and smote in the camp of the Assyrians an hundred fourscore and five thousand: and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they were all dead corpses.--19:35
